RUTH SINGER DISCRETIONARY FUND AND SYLVIA LYNN FUND CLOSE

“Dr. Ruth” Singer was known for going above and beyond the call of duty. As Chase Brexton’s resident STD expert, she constantly went out of her way to provide direct assistance to her patients, often paying for their eyeglasses. In the early 1990s, Chase Brexton established The Ruth Singer Eyeglass Fund, later renamed The Dr. Ruth Singer Discretionary Fund, in recognition of her hard work. Dr. Ruth retired in 2000 and passed away on May 27, 2013.

This fund was complemented by the Sylvia Lynn Fund, also established in the 1990s, that provided assistance to HIV-positive mothers, set up by Carla Alexander, Chase Brexton’s director of clinical affairs in the 1990s.

Since both funds are no longer active, Chase Brexton has decided to close them funds. However, just as Dr. Ruth did, we welcome you to directly help our patients by joining the Hope Lives Here program where, for as little as \$10/month, you can commit to helping your neighbors. Mark Sam comes from a long line of health care professionals. His uncle, a pharmacist, worked three jobs to put four kids through school. His mother was one of the first nurses in the state of California to treat patients with HIV. When other nurses refused to have any physical contact with these patients, Mark’s mother took it upon herself to make sure they received the care they needed, even when that meant making house calls in her spare time.

It was this belief in caring for those who need it most that inspired Mark to become the first person to enroll in Chase Brexton’s newest fundraising initiative, Hope Lives Here. This program allows donors to make recurring annual donations to help Chase Brexton continue to serve Maryland’s most vulnerable populations.

Hope Lives Here is open to all in the community, including individuals, families, small businesses, and corporate partners. 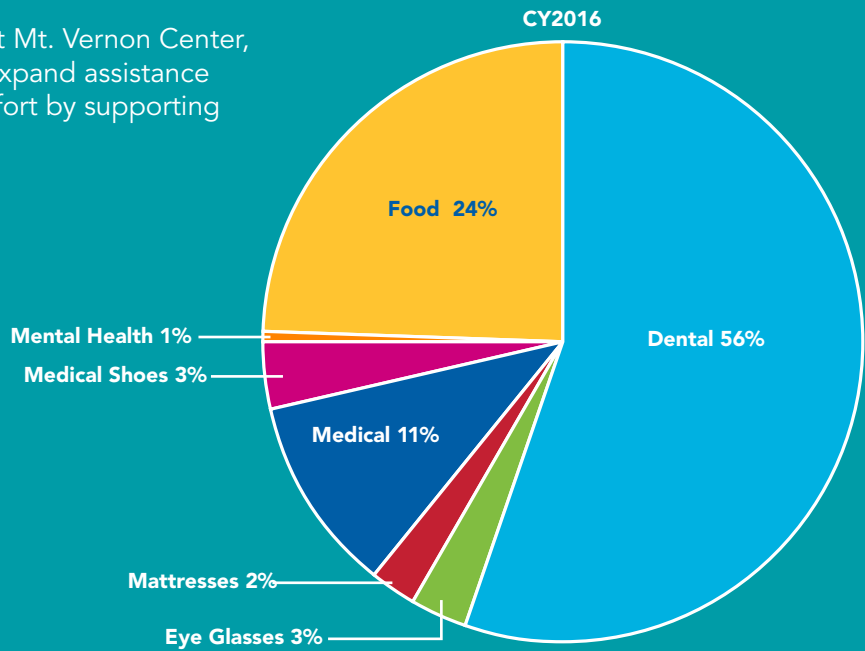

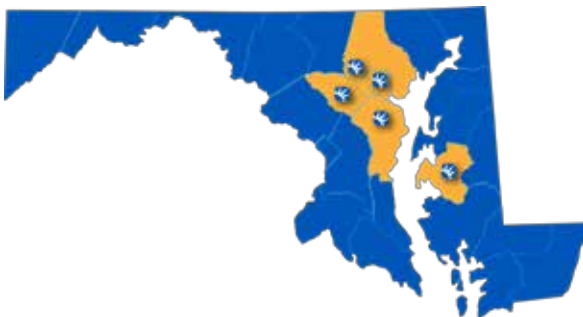
