



WELCOME TO CHASE BREXTON HEALTH CARE


CHASE BREXTON HEALTH CARE: STATS & DEMOGRAPHICS FY2018




PATIENT FEDERAL POVERTY LEVELS (FPL)




IDENTIFY AS GENDER DIVERSE



LGB+ SEXUAL ORIENTATION




HOPE LIVES HERE FUND DISTRIBUTIONS IN FY2019



CAUSE - RELATED MARKETING

Examples

1 A pre-agreed amount goes to a selected charity:

Brands may then market this as a total amount which goes to a charity such as "Help Us Raise \$1m For Charity"

OR

Brands may set an amount per pack sold and then print the right amount of boxes for the pre-agreed amount.



2 All profits or a % of the profits from sales is donated to the charity.



3 Brands pay a licensing fee to use the logo.



Cause-related marketing partnerships offer companies an opportunity to sell their product/service and donate a percentage of the sales receipts to Chase Brexton Health Care (CBHC).

This unique co-branding opportunity allows a company to promote their public service work and promote the mission of the charitable organization. This is a collaborative effort between a for-profit brand and a non-profit organization for mutual benefit, including:

- Co-brand apparel to promote and raise money for the charity during an event (i.e. Pride month)
- Co-branding and product placement in stores throughout the year (i.e. placing CBHC's mission on your product label in stores highlighting your social impact)
